

How to use and get the most out Oxford Owl






Step 2: Use 'My class login' to logon using our class login details below:



Step 5: Select the correct age group.






Step 6: Select your child's book band.





During Year 3, children usually <u>start</u> the year reading <u>'gold band'</u> books and by the end of the year we try to support them in progressing to <u>'grey band'</u> books ready for Year 4. The majority of children in Year 3 were reading 'brown and grey banded' books in March 2020. A small number of children were reading books beyond 'grey band' and below 'brown band'. **Please try to keep to the colour band that your child was reading in school and seek guidance before moving your child onto a harder book band.** It is important you child can <u>understand</u> as well as read the words in the book band they are on. Research suggests children cannot comprehend unless they understand 90% of the words in a book.

Step 7: Select a book.




Step 8: Get familiar with the reading tools to navigate through a book.
