<p style="text-align: center;">Be Yourself! <i>PSHE</i></p> <p>Draw around yourself or draw a big picture of yourself. Around the outside write words and phrases that describe you, things you are good at. Add nice things that people have ever said about you. Then read it back and look at what an amazing person you are!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Family Comparisons <i>History</i></p> <p>Talk to an older relative about their childhood.</p> <p>What did they like to do? What was their favourite toy? Where did they go on holiday? What was school like?</p> <p>What are the similarities/ differences to your childhood?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Be a Reporter <i>ICT/English</i></p> <p>Can you create your own news report on a topic of your choice?</p> <p>Get a family member to film it for you. You could even include another family member to interview in your report.</p> <p>Challenge: Turn your news report into a newspaper report. What might be different about the language you use?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">I Wanna Be A Radio Presenter! <i>Music/PSHE</i></p> <p>Put together a playlist of songs that make you happy or mean something to you.</p> <p>Then sit back and relax whilst listening to it. Remember to introduce each song like a radio presenter.</p> <p>Proud of your playlist? Share it with your teacher and they might share it with the class!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Ready... Set... GO! <i>PE/Maths</i></p> <p>Create an obstacle course inside or outside.</p> <p>Time yourself and family members completing the course.</p> <p>Who is the champion?</p> <p>Can you record your results in a table? Remember to write these in child friendly language.</p> <p>How might you present this information in a way that is interesting for the reader?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Be a Spanish Teacher! <i>Languages</i></p> <p>Create a poster showing some of the vocabulary you have learnt in Spanish (e.g. colours, animals, numbers – look on Google Classroom for support materials) Can you teach members of your family?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Caring for nature <i>Science/DT</i></p> <p><i>With the help of an adult and using recyclable items make a bug hotel or bird feeder.</i></p> <p><i>(Look on Google Classroom or online for ideas and instructions)</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Animal Hideouts! <i>Science</i></p> <p>Draw a map of your garden.
