## Design a superhero's Hideout

You are a scientist/engineer and have been asked to design a hideout for a superhero (the superhero you designed).

Draw a picture of your hideout. Label your picture with words to describe location, appearance, materials and special features.

Use the design sheet or create your own.

Want to take this activity further? Make a model of your hideout.

Things to think about when designing your hideout:

- 1. Where will it be located? You want it to be somewhere no one will find it...
- 2. What kind of defences will the hideout have?
- 3. What will be inside the hideout?
- 4. How will your superhero get in and out of the hideout? A secret entrance? Emergency exit?
- 5. Where will your superhero's suit and transport be kept?

#### Design a superhero's Transport

You are a scientist/engineer and have been asked to design a mode of transport for a superhero (the superhero you designed).

Draw a picture of your transport. Label your picture with words to describe appearance, materials and special features.

Use the design sheet or create your own.

Want to take this activity further? Make a model of your transport.

Things to think about when designing your transport:

- 1. What type of vehicle is it?
- 2. Will the vehicle be able to transform to flv/sail etc?
- 3. What defences/ gadgets will the vehicle have?
- 4. Will the vehicle have any special communication tools?




